**Reading (Ages & Stages)**

Listen to and join in with stories and poems.

Count to and across 100, forwards and backwards, beginning with 0 (National Curriculum).  
Read and write numbers 1 to 20 in numerals and words (National Curriculum).

**Humanities**

Where is Doncaster in England? What do you like about Doncaster? What other famous cities are there in Britain? Can you recognise key British cities on a map? (Geography)  
Can you recognise famous British buildings? (History)  
Can you recognise common artefacts in a church; Crucifix Bible, Candle, Pews, Windows? (Religious Education)
