

Year 5IC – Eco Workshop: Mini Beasts

Year 5 took part in a Mini Beast workshop where pupils learnt about different animals and their habitats.

Activity 1: Habitats

Pupils discussed how humans could make a habitat for animals and how they could also use recyclable material. Pupils went to explore the bug hotels situated on the school grounds. Pupils discussed why it is important to look after animals and their habitats.

Activity 2: Bug Research

Pupils explored Lower and Upper School playground searching for mini beasts. Each time they found one they ticked it off their survey. Pupils enjoyed searching for these animals. Once back in class we learnt about these animals (what they ate, where they live, etc.)

Activity 3: Design a habitat for an animal

Pupils designed what they thought would be a good habitat for different animals and shared their pictures with the group. Pupils focused on using recyclable materials to make the habitats.
