### Beach Clean Up at Fitties beach, Cleethorpes

As part of our Eco Week activities pupils in Year 6 and Year 11 took part in a beach clean-up at Fitties Beach near Cleethorpes. These pupils were given an opportunity to experience the impact of human actions on our seas and oceans and learned about appropriate actions they can take to ensure marine conservation for the next generation.

The trip will be supported by specialist staff working for North East Lincolnshire Council.

Pupils really enjoyed the visit, but were shocked at the amount of litter in and around our seas and coastline. Pupils reflected on the impact of human activity and were keen to communicate to others the importance of disposing of litter and waste appropriately.

As a group we collected 4 black sacks of waste from the sea, beach and shore line in a 2-hour period. The pupils were happy with their achievements in making our beaches and coastlines a safer place for animals and a nicer place to visit.
